

# MONTANA HUMAN RIGHTS NETWORK VOTING RECORD

## 2001 MONTANA LEGISLATURE

(s) MHRN supported bill.

### **HB 233** -- Rep. Brad Newman (D-Butte)

This bill would have added sexual orientation to Montana's hate crimes law. The bill failed in the House Judiciary Committee. The recorded House vote is on a motion by Rep. Newman to bring the bill from the committee to the House floor. The motion failed 47-52. (s)

### **SB 266** -- Sen. Jon Ellingson (D-Missoula)

The bill would have amended Montana's wrongful discharge laws to protect gay men and lesbians from being fired from their jobs due solely to their sexual orientation. The bill failed in the Senate Judiciary Committee. The recorded vote is on a motion by Sen. Ellingson to bring the bill from the committee to the Senate floor. The motion failed 20-30. (s)

### **HB 189** --- Rep. Bill Eggers (D-Crow Agency)

The bill would have required collection of data related to race during traffic stops to provide information on racial profiling. The bill failed on the House floor on the third reading. 43-56. (s)

### **HB 465** -- Rep. Christine Kaufmann (D-Helena)

The bill would have abolished the death penalty in Montana. The bill failed on the second reading on the House floor, 36-64. (s)

### **HB 547** -- Rep. Bob Davies (R-Bozeman)

The bill would have criminalized injury to a fetus, granting person status to a fetus in Montana law. The bill passed the House 59-40 (third reading) and failed in the Senate Judiciary Committee. A motion to bring the bill to the Senate floor failed 20-30. (o)

### **HB 272** -- Rep. Alan Olson (R-Roundup)

The bill allows local school boards to determine the amount of time a student may be released from public school for religious studies, rather than limiting the time to two hours per week. The bill passed the House, 67-33 (second reading), and the Senate, 31-16 (second reading) and was signed into law. (o)

### **HB 364** -- Rep. Aubyn Curtiss (R-Fortine)

The bill would have set up a council to advance state sovereignty over the federal government. The bill died on second reading in the House, 37-62. (o)

### **HJ 19** -- Rep. Aubyn Curtiss (R-Fortine)

The resolution urged the U.S. Congress and the President to overturn the federal roadless initiative. The resolution passed the House, 69-31, and the Senate, 30-20. (o)

### **HB 53** -- Carol Juneau (D-Browning)

The bill would have allowed schools on reservations, or schools with over 50% Indian students, to apply a hiring preference for Indian teachers with equal qualifications. The bill died in House committee. A motion to bring the bill to the floor was defeated, 42-53. (s)
